📖 Please make sure that your child does not wear any jewellery.


📖 Please write your child's name on all their clothes, including hats, scarves and gloves.

<p>Communication and Language</p>		<p>This term we will be continuing to focus on developing our language skills. We will be practising using simple phrases and sentences to communicate with each other. We will also be exploring any new vocabulary in the story.</p>
<p>Maths</p>		<p>We will continue to focus on developing our understanding of numbers, particularly with counting out one, two or three objects from a larger group. We will also be developing our one to one counting. Also, we will begin to explore and experiment with shape this term, as well as investigating size.</p>
<p>Topic</p>		<p>We will be focusing our learning around the story of 'Diggersaurus' this term. It's a new book which has been recommended by Love My Books website and has links to both construction sites and dinosaurs. We will be basing our learning around both of these topics and will even be going on local trips. We are hoping to transform our role play areas so we can have a go at being dinosaur archaeologists and workers on a building site. We can't wait!</p>
