Look at Year 4's lovely smart line! It is really important that we all start the day like this and on time at 8:50 ready for learning.

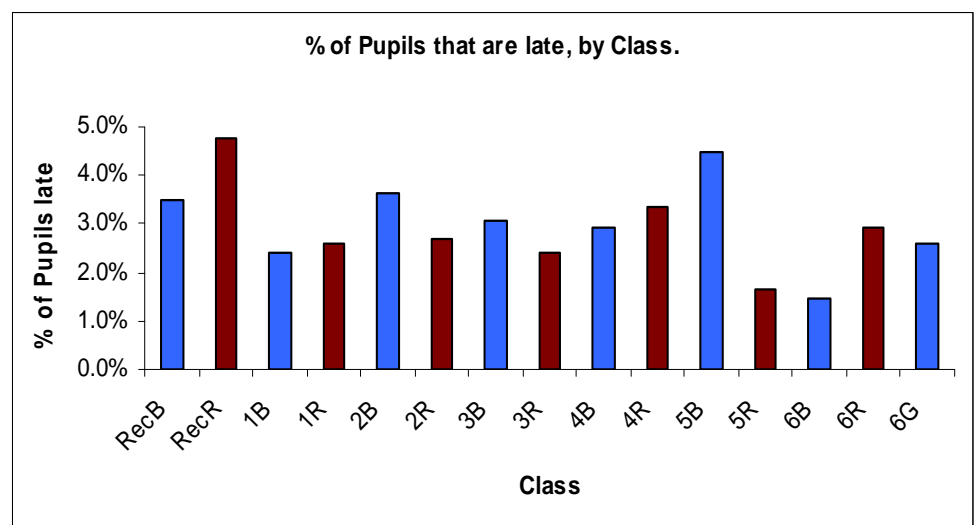
The children are receiving tokens this term for arriving at school on time. As usual the class with the most tokens will be given a treat at the end of term.
