### What will my child be learning this term?

<b>NUMERACY</b>	Using and applying maths skills	As well as consolidating the key skills, the 4 operations and place value, we are going to set up our own business! Linked to our garden project, the children will be given a small budget to research and create a business plan.
<b>LITERACY</b>	There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom	Last term we enjoyed the book <i>There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom</i> so much we have decided to base our Literacy lessons around it this term. We will be writing in the role of Bradley, exploring his feelings and emotions, doing lots of drama and role play, and even basing an art topic on Bradley's self identity!
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Plants and Living Things	This term we are growing our own vegetables! We will be planting seeds, making observations about their growth, then re-planting the seedlings into the year 5 area of our new school garden. At the end of the year we hope to be able to share our produce!
<b>HISTORY</b>	Ancient Greece	We will be re-enacting Greek myths and writing our own, looking at Ancient Greek artefacts and tasting Greek food! We will hold our own mini-Olympics and create some Ancient Greek stage props!
